To close the meeting, Mr. Jackson outlined the next steps in the process, noting that a statutory meeting will be scheduled once the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing completes its review of the Official Plan. Additionally, another working meeting with Council will be held to incorporate feedback from the Open House and Public Meeting. The goal is to pass the Zoning By-law and Adopt the Official Plan by the end of this year. In the *Planning Act*, Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing has 120 days to review and provide a decision on the Township's adopted Official Plan. This period allows the Ministry to evaluate the plan to ensure it aligns with provincial policies and regulations.
